Meetings

The club meets on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month from February to November, the first meeting of the month being a competition night and the second a workshop night.

Competition nights

This is where members present their work to be critiqued, within their own grade, either by a PSNZ or other invited judge; who will award the image a grade. (See Award points) On a trophy night, the best image is selected from honours images across all grades and that image will be awarded the trophy.

Workshop nights

Can be anything from learning how to take that 'honours photo' to having a guest speaker. (Refer annual programme)

Start Time

The hall will be open from 7pm and the last images are to be submitted before 7.20pm for a 7.30pm start.

Visitors

Visitors will be most welcome. They will be looked after by a club member on their visit and offered a complimentary supper (tea, coffee & biscuits) Visitors may join the Society anytime, but after their 3rd visit they will be invited to join.

Membership

Membership to the Society is by completing an application form on the club's web site (hendersonphoto.org.nz) and by payment of an annual subscription (or a pro-rata proportion).
